Standard Operating Guidelines Minimum Officer Qualifications

1. Lieutenant and Chief Engineer

1. Fire Fighter I
2. 2 years of active service in the Brooklin Fire Department
3. Display proficiency in the operation of all apparatus (including pumping) and all other fire department equipment
4. Additional standards for Water Supply Lieutenant and Chief Engineer
 1. Pumps I
5. Additional standards for Lieutenant, Fire Attack
 1. IS-100 or IS 700 Certification

2. Captain

All the requirements of Lieutenant, plus:

1. 1 additional year, for a total of 3 years of active service in the Brooklin Fire Department
2. Additional standards for Water Supply Captain
 1. Pumps I & II
3. Additional standards for Captain, Fire Attack
 1. Tactics I
 2. Advanced Fire Attack

3. Chief and Assistant Chief

All the requirements of Captain, plus:

1. 2 additional years, for a total of 5 years of active service in the Brooklin Fire Department
2. Tactics I & II **OR**
3. Leadership I & II

4. Exceptions & Nominations

1. The Board of Directors can override any Department Standard Operating Guidelines in any emergency or other situation where such override is called for.
2. The Board of Directors can determine that equivalent experience satisfies any of the minimum standards for any position
3. The Board of Directors will serve as the nominating committee each year for all officer and board positions. Other nominations from the membership will be equally accepted at the annual meeting.
