Who needs to attend S-130/S-190 (basic wildland fire courses)?

This class is open to all, with preference going to those who are active members of a fire department and those who have not taken wildland classes before. Those that have previously attended wildland classes or the HCFFA Academy are welcome to register to further their training. Each class limited to 20 participants.

Firefighters interested in being paid Call-When-Needed firefighters for the Maine Forest Service are highly encouraged to take these classes. At some point in the future, this class will be a requirement prior to MFS employment. These courses meet the minimum requirements for mobilization out of state on Maine Forest Service crews.

Online option:

The S-130/S-190 courses can be taken online for those unable to make these course dates. However, online participants still need to take part in an 8-hour field day. Our field day (scheduled for March 31) will be open to students who have completed the online courses, but you must contact a Forest Ranger in advance to attend.

Class attendance / weather:

Class attendance is important. However, life events always come up. The schedule for classes in Sedgwick and Franklin will mirror each other. If you are unable to attend your normally scheduled evening, attending the other class is strongly encouraged. Attendance for the Saturday field day is mandatory.

Courses will only be cancelled for weather if state government offices are closed. If we have multiple cancellations, we may extend into the first week of April on the same evening schedule.
